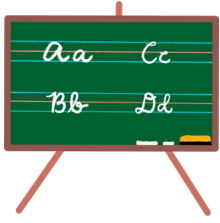

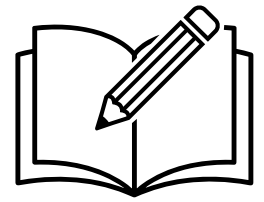

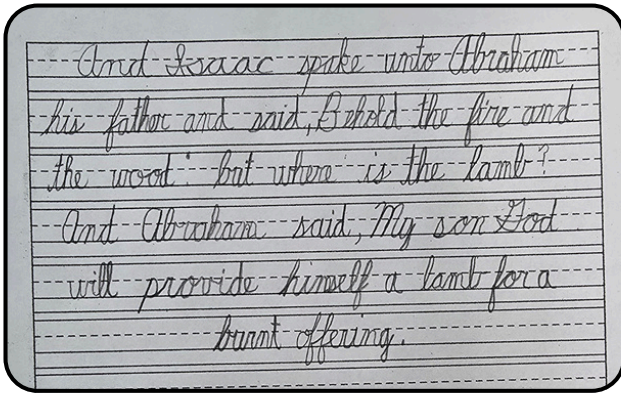


# Classroom Rule #5

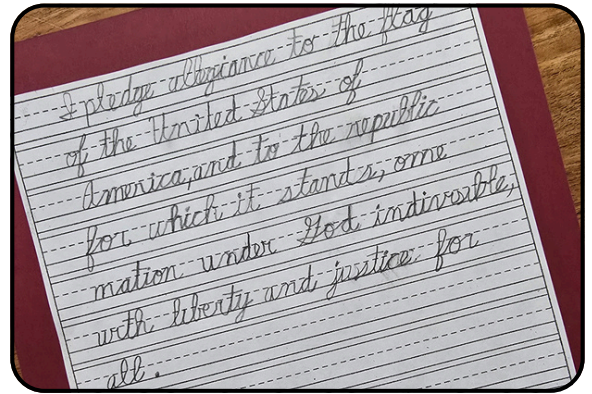
## Always try your best!



We only have 5 classroom rules at TCA, and Rule #5 is to “Always try your best”. As Will Durant, summarizing Aristotle, puts it - **“We are what we repeatedly do, therefore, excellence is not an act, but a habit”**. As simple as this rule sounds, it is not innate for young students to try their best in everything that they do. It is easier to rush through the math work sheet, scribble a copybook illustration, and write quick workbook answers to get it done faster. 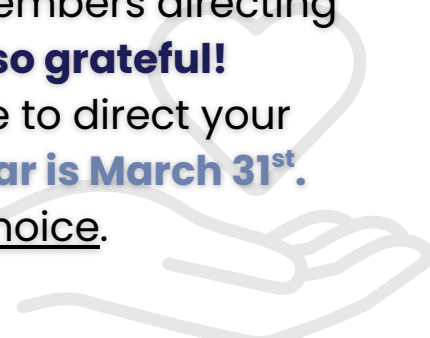
